

A Bowl Full of Cherries!

We can even sort the same kind of fruit into different types. We can separate a big bowl of cherries into single cherries and double cherries. Let "c" represent "single cherries" and let "c²" represent "double cherries".

Simplify each expression by separating the double cherries  from the single cherries .
